Uniform Policy

Guidelines for Kindergarten through Grade 6 are as follows:

SHIRTS:

- Plain white, dark navy or red with collars (only deviation is polo with school logo)
- Long or short sleeves
- White t-shirts may be worn under the white collared shirts.

PANTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, SCOOTERS AND JUMPERS:

- Khaki or Navy only for pants and shorts with inside pockets in the back.
- Plaid, Khaki or Navy only for skirts, jumpers, skorts
- Shorts may be worn in September, May and June only.
- No cargo, skinny, carpenter, jean-style pants/shorts.
- Modest lengths – fingertip length or longer.

SWEATERS:

- Pullover, cardigan, vest, crew or v-neck only.
- Solid red or solid navy.
- White collared shirt must be worn underneath.

SWEATSHIRTS:

- School logoed sweatshirts are acceptable (ordered through the school office).
- White collared shirt must be worn underneath.

FLEECE VESTS AND JACKETS:

- Only school fleece are acceptable (ordered through Donald's Uniform)
- White collared shirt must be worn underneath.

SOCKS, TIGHTS, AND HAIR ACCESSORIES:

- White, navy, red or khaki only.
- Socks are required at all times.

SHOES:

- Must be safe and appropriate for school.
- Tennis shoes are acceptable.

BELTS:

- Preferred but not required.
- Brown, black, khaki, navy, red, or white.

- Any jewelry worn must be simple and modest.
- Ear piercing is acceptable with a limit of one piercing per ear. Post earrings only.
- No facial piercings, tattoos or dyed hair.
- Students must dress appropriately for seasonal weather.
- Hats, mittens/gloves, boots and jackets are required for winter. Snow pants are required.
- Out of uniform days are at the discretion of the principal.
- The principal will review all fads.
